

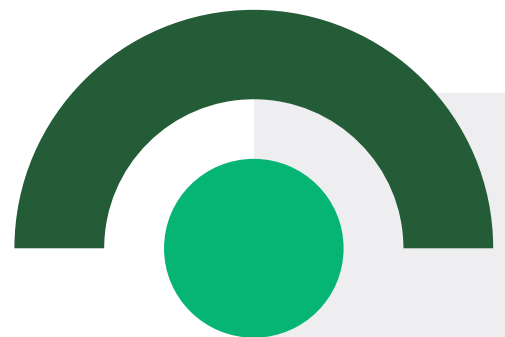

Content Academies
